Authors should be separated by commas and marked with superscript when necessary to distinguish authors from different affiliations. Author's affiliations should be written in separate rows when there are more than one, 12 points, italic, centered. The e-mail address of corresponding author should be 12 points, centered and is followed by two blank lines. Abstract text should be 12 points, justified on middle.



Figures or photographs must be incorporated electronically into the text. Please do not attach figures or photographs as separate files.
